

Creative Movement Posters

Suggestions for Use:

You can use this PDF like a PowerPoint by choosing to view it in Full Screen Mode. I prefer to print and laminate the posters so that I can walk around the room while students are dancing to encourage them and redirect those that may make inappropriate choices. Printing them also makes it easy to let students choose the order of movements by picking cards to hold up.

When using these cards, I start by explaining that they are free to create their own movements based on the cards I hold up.
Although there isn't a specific action to do, some actions may be inappropriate. In my room, we don't run and we don't roll around on the floor because it creates a safety hazard for other dancers I let students have a few seconds of freestyle movement when the music starts and then I'll hold up the first card. Sometimes we'll repeat actions and sometimes we'll just go straight through the cards.









