

Roles of Composer and Librettist


Cut out the parallelogram and fold on the dotted lines. Inside, write the roles of the composer and the librettist in creating an opera.








When you glue down the book, make sure to glue only around the outermost edges and not in the center. You want the slider to remain free to move side to side. BLANK version for the child who loves to draw.









Famous Opera Composers Pletal Books


